### Miami International Airport

**La Carreta** The airport outpost of Miami's well-known Cuban chain is open 24 hours, serving favorites like pressed, portable French-bread sandwiches including the Cubano, made with roast pork, Swiss cheese, and pickles, and the smaller medianoches ("midnight") made with ham, cheese, and pickles (Terminal D, post-security).
